Agenda Item #10: General Business

- Bunkhouse safety Chubb advised that an inspection register for the building's smoke alarms and EXIT signs is available for a cost of \$99. JMcG moved that the club purchase the register, a new smoke alarm and new EXIT sign and have installed by Paul Garner. Seconded DMF. Carried.
- Initial Membership Fees to be \$190.00 including a once only joining fee and mowing fee.
- Online meeting platform AL Sim presented a very good report on online meeting platforms Zoom and Gotomeeting. It was agreed that we would trial Zoom in the week of 20th January. If the trial is successful, Al Sim moved that the club purchase a ZOOM subscription for a fee of \$231 per annum. Seconded TE. Carried.
- It was approved that the club purchase a quantity of KSC stubby coolers to the value of \$330.00. JMcG to organize.
- Topdressing 16/34 It was decided to leave further top dressing work until after the coming October Nationals.
- Multiclass Nationals Since we will be hosting this competition, it was decided to ask DDSC if they would host the Qld State Comps which had already been allocated to us. TE to make this request.
- Grant update: Latest one requesting \$2000.00 was refused probably due to our Incorporation/ name change
- Incorporation JMcG advised he has commenced de-registration of KSC. Currently KGC has ABN, is registered for GST and for fuel tax rebate.
- SBRC It was resolved to form a sub-committee to formulate a long term plan for our bunkhouse /accommodation requirements complete with plans and costings and liase with SBRC.
- Brisbane Airshow ND requested approval to have a glider/towing display at this airshow later in the year.
 Georgo would take his JS3 and ND would take one of our tugs to launch him. Both would be on static display during the event. This arrangement was approved.
- Allocation of Duo for 2 seat Nationals. Miles Gore-Brown to be given first preference. Dave Jansen as backup.
- GoMembership problems JMcG and KH to come up with "How to" sheets for both club and GFA memberships to resolve some issues.
- Yearly Planner perhaps organize extra social functions and plan ahead re these. Try to get a monthly online newsletter going again similar to the old "Running on Empty" that used to me mailed out.

- Committee to look into providing an online purchase platform to enable pre payment for Joyflights/AEF's within our existing website.
- Member's accounts JMcG informed that there are quite a few outstanding amounts owed by members to the Club – particularly by juniors and that it would be good to tighten up requirement that all members accounts be in credit.
- Location of Ray Stewarts caravan Committee members inspected the caravan area during the meeting and the general concensus was to leave the designated location stand. Changing to the eastern side would involve supply of new electrical circuit which the club is not prepared to do at this stage. DMF to advise Mark Dalton of decision.
